1. INFORMATION

- a. The Hosting Range is Riverside Range
 - i. Firing will be conducted at the Riverside indoor range.
 - ii. Riverside range rules must be followed as set by the Riverside Range Rules.
 - iii. Guests must have an online **3-month** waiver and sponsored by a Riverside Range member.
- b. Shooting Season
 - i. Length: An 8-week league.
 - ii. The night match is Monday*
 - iii. Dates: March 16 – May 4, 2026
 - iv. Prize award and Challenge Match Night May 11th.
 - v. CMP/USCCA Membership optional
- c. Individual competition only.

 - a. Pistol \$30.00 per classification
 - b. Rifle \$30.00 per classification
 - c. Both \$55.00 (Senior \$55.00)
 - d. CMP/USCCA GROUP Membership discount \$10.00
 - e. CMP Membership discount \$5.00
 - f. Fees are due prior to the start of season with Zelle or cash payment to RSO.
 - ii. CMP 24952 reserves the right to limit the number of shooters per classification/event.
 - iii. Competitors must complete a minimum of 5 match shoots to be eligible for any awards/drawings.
2. Rule Book will be available online, copy at the range office.
3. Tournament Classifications
- a. Open: Rifle & Handgun: Scopes, Optical sights, Light gathering scopes, Muzzle brakes and Barrel weights permitted. No active projection on Target.





- b. Limited: Rifle & Handgun: Iron Sights, Adjustable & Fiberoptic Permitted. No Optical or Electronic Sights, No Compensators, No barrel weights, No enclosed handgrips
- c. Classes within **Limited & Open** Divisions: Adult / Senior (65+). (Must have 3 participants in the class for award)

4. Targets

- a. The [Local CMP website](#) will provide all targets online.
- b. All Targets will be marked by the Competitor with Competitor's name (must be legible) and target number
- c. If you use printed target from website, please use a thicker gauge paper or tape the paper target to a piece of cardboard.

5. Shooting League Targets

- a. *League targets may be shot any day throughout the week and at any time that the range is open. You may shoot targets for the prior week if you were away and you may shoot targets for the week ahead if you are away. No more than 1 target may be shot for slow fire string. For the rapid fire string you may shoot just 1 target or a target for each 5 shot string. No more than **2 (possibly 3) targets** may be shot in a single week. *
- b. The scored portion of your shooting requires that you advise the RSO so that they may possibly to keep time for you. If not available, then a club member and request that they sign the target.
- c. Competitor Standings will be determined by the Average of the 20 shot aggregate scores for each week

6. Course of Fire

- a. All **pistol firings** will be 7 yards for limited and 15 yards for open, Competition may be shot 2 handed. Senior (65+) Competition may be shot from seated position with no part of the body may touch the table.
- b. .22 caliber Rimfire pistols for Pistol Class (Revolver or Semi-Auto capable of firing 5 shots in Ten Seconds – Any NRA Allowed Sight)
- c. Weekly Match –





1. 10 Shots Slow Fire (one ten shot string, 5 minutes for the string).
 2. 10 Shots Timed Fire (fired in two 5 shot strings, 15 seconds for each string).
- d. All **rifle firing** will be at 25 yards; Competition will be shot from seated position elbows rested on table slings permitted. Any rest may be used to shoot from the bench, so long as any such rest prevents the barreled action from being affixed to the bench in an immovable manner. A rear bag is permitted. No part of the rifle or Magazine may touch the firing lane table.
- e. .22 caliber Rimfire Rifle for Rifle Class (Semi-Auto or bolt action capable of firing 5 shots in Ten Seconds – Any NRA Allowed Sight)
- f. Weekly Match–
1. 10 Shots Slow Fire (one ten shot string, 5 minutes for the string)
 2. 10 Shots Timed Fire (fired in two 5 shot strings, 15 seconds for each string)

7. Scoring- All weekly scores to count

- a. Targets
- i. Targets will be scored by a CMP Match Director
 - ii. Competitors' targets will also mark their full name (must be legible) on the targets
 - iii. Scoring Plugs may not be used except by a Match Director.
 - iv. When a scoring plug is used, all parties must agree to the score value prior to removing the plug.
 - v. Overlays will be used to determine doubles – plugs cannot be used.
 - vi. Match Director will impound all targets after the firing session for score verification and entering scores into database – to be returned to the shooter after scores are entered, if requested, or if discrepancies arise.
- b. Score Eligibility
- i. Scores will be recorded by Competitor Name for every completed match
 - ii. A shooting session must be completed (all 20 shots accounted for) for scores to be submitted for entry.





8. Alibis/Issues: One re-fire during the Slow Fire Stage, and one re-fire during the sustained fire stage is possible – No competitor will be allowed more than one re-fire because of the defective cartridge, disabled rifle or malfunction.

9. NRA Classifications

- a. Individual – based on the first 80 shots for unclassified shooters, Last year’s competitors will start with their last standing classification
- b. Scores
 - i. Master – 95% and above
 - ii. Expert – 90% to 94.99%
 - iii. Sharpshooter – 85% to 89.99
 - iv. Marksman below 85%

10. Awards

- a. Prize money will be based on the number of competitors in the league.
- b. Ties will be broken by X count, then average
- c. Rifle League Champion
- d. Pistol League Champion
- e. Individual awards **May be** given out. Must have 3 competitors in Class
 - i. One for Each Division champion
 - ii. Most Improved
 - 1. Pistol
 - 2. Rifle
 - iii. Senior League Champion
 - iv. 2nd place may be awarded.
